All camps have a set curriculum designed by PSA's Director of Coaching and professional staff. The Director of Coaching and the professional staff are highly qualified soccer individuals who hold accredited licenses from the United States Soccer Federation and/ or the National Soccer Coaches Association of America. These individuals are hired by the PSA Board.

The curriculum is designed to tailor to each particular age group with age appropriate games and activities. This curriculum is based upon US Soccer's recommended training curriculum for all youth players in the country. Each camper can expect to have an enjoyable experience that fosters learning, but also allows the players to challenge themselves each day. The professional staff strives to make each camp day a fun one in a safe and rewarding environment.

The Young Legends Camp is geared to those children who are just starting soccer. The PSA Camp Staff has outlined an age-appropriate curriculum for these young future stars. The curriculum includes introductory games and activities that help each player become comfortable with the soccer ball at their feet. It will also include small sided games that each player will participate in during the last 30 minutes of each day. The curriculum includes:

- ⇒ *Body mechanics which require balance, agility, foot-eye coordination, and strength*
- ⇒ *Introduction to basics of soccer: dribbling, passing, and shooting*
- ⇒ *Small-sided games, 3v3 to 4v4*
- ⇒ *Activities to develop their enjoyment for the game*
- ⇒ *Exposure to all of the PSA Camp Staff*
- ⇒ *Fun*

The PSA Day Camp is intended to develop the basic skills of the recreational players. The PSA Camp Staff has developed a curriculum that will develop basic soccer skills and challenge these players as well. The curriculum will include training drills, fun activities, and small sided games to reach the above goals. Each group will be broken off by age and/ or the ability of the players. You can expect your player to learn a variety of different soccer skills and develop a further enjoyment of the game of soccer.

The curriculum includes:

- ⇒ *Dribbling techniques to help beat players off the dribble*
- ⇒ *Receiving and passing techniques*
- ⇒ *Finishing techniques through the use of a variety of games*
- ⇒ *Activities that encourage team-building, sportsmanship, and respect for others*
- ⇒ *Small-sided games, 3v3 and 4v4*
- ⇒ *Street Soccer Tournament*
- ⇒ *Exposure to all the PSA Camp Staff which includes some of the area's top coaches and some former professional players*
- ⇒ *Fun*

Notice For All Players

- All players are expected to bring their own water bottle
